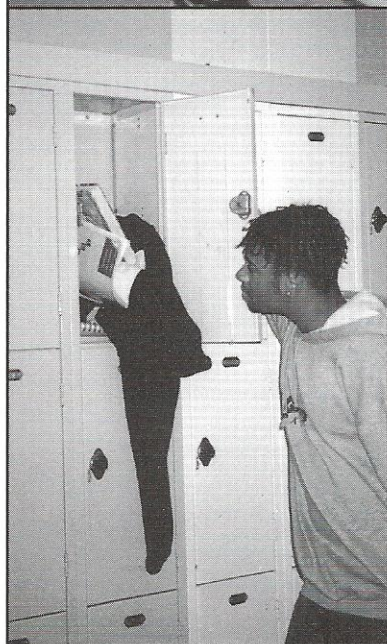
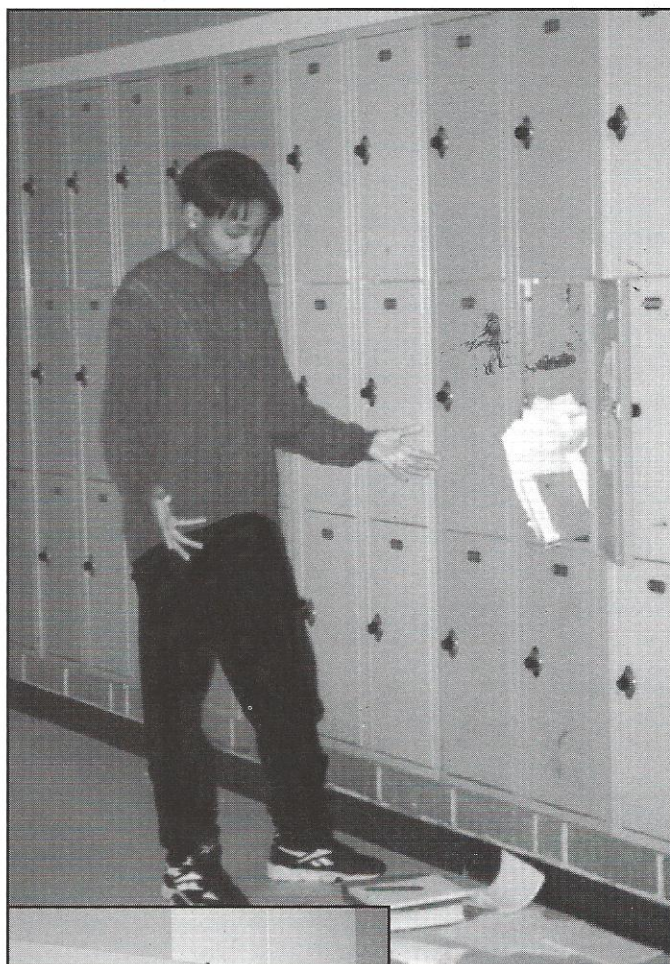


What A Mess!
