When the time came for the winner to be announced during halftime, Margaret was escorted onto the field by Erick Bright, and Christy was escorted by Garrett Ulrich.

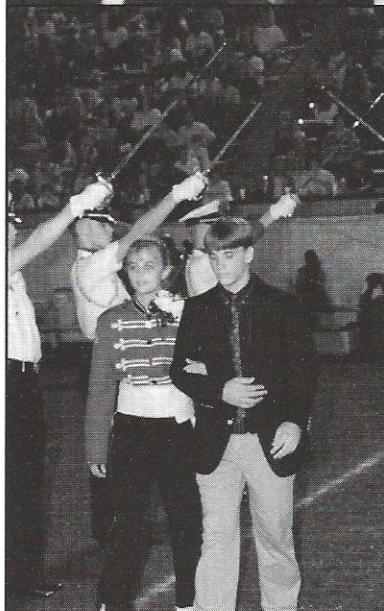
After both girls walked under the arch of the NJROTC's swords, Margaret was named Miss Freshman.
