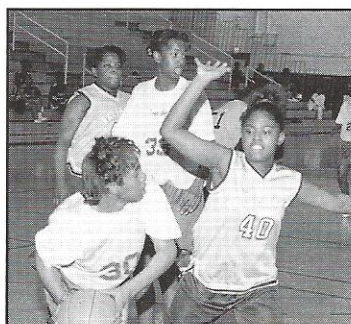
The Dynamic Duo At Work
