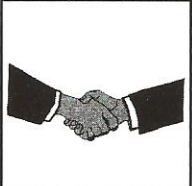

Students could get involved in many ways. By saying "please" and "thank you," they were given free Pringles. Each class chose a Mr. and

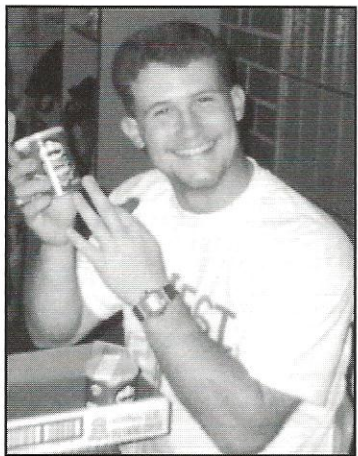

Hefner and Darryl Bar-tley, the jun-iors; and Donald You-mans and Sheetal Pa-tel, the sen-iors.

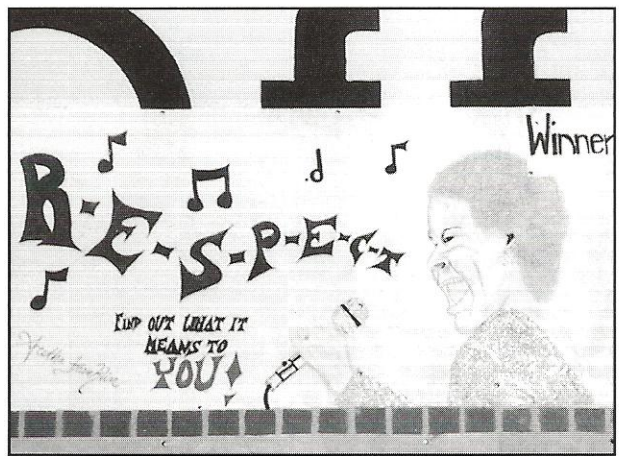
This voting system also gave the clas-ses an oppor-tunity to earn money. Each class earned plenty, but the seniors came out on top with \$190.85.
