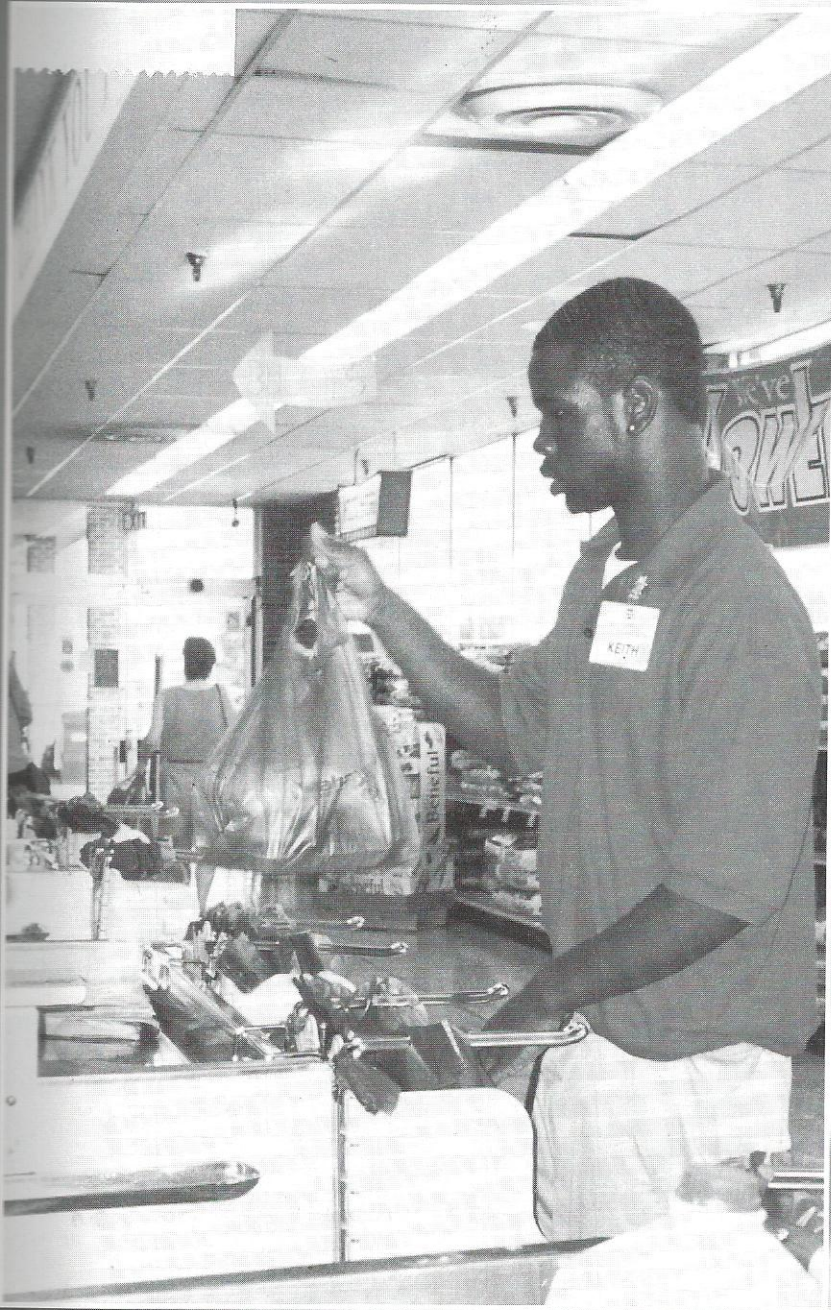



# glory daze

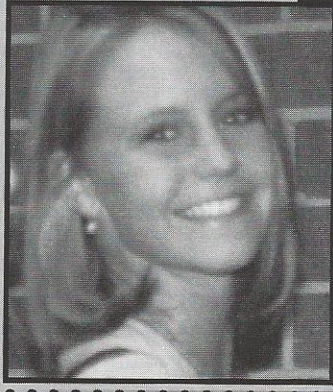
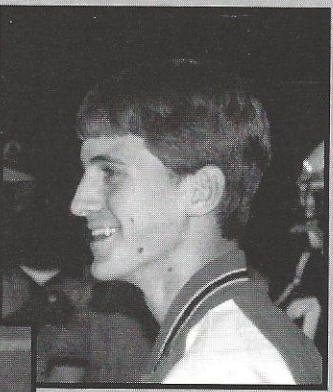
