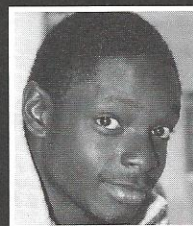


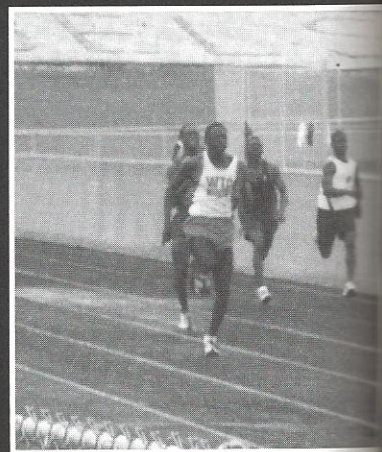
Rising Stars



NATHAN BRELAND, 12TH



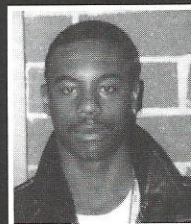
