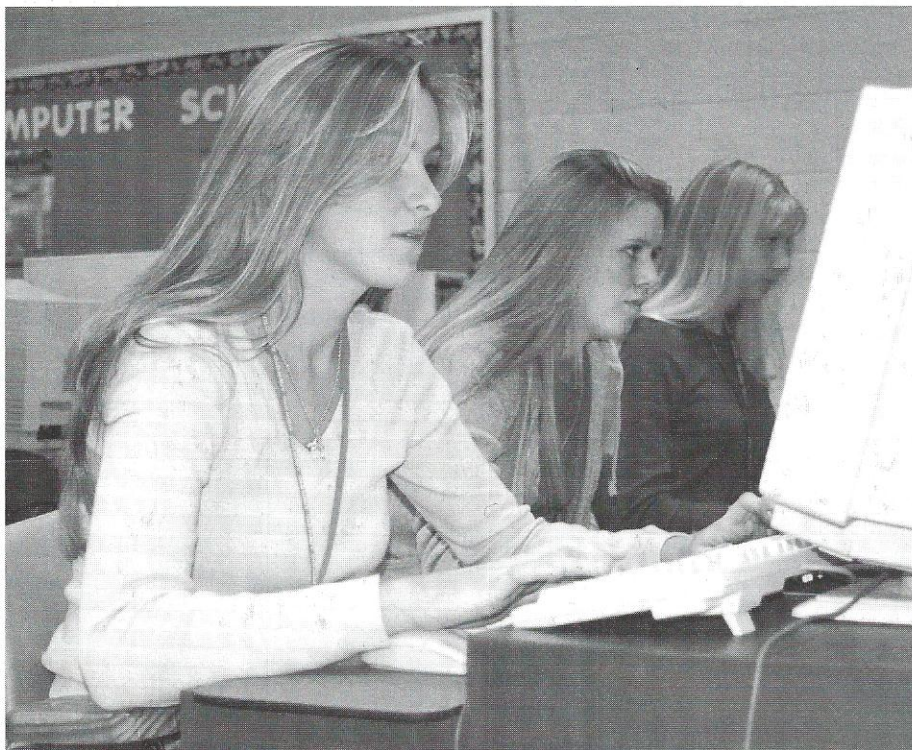
"We use computers and software
